



Attorney Phillips did not send the actions from his phone to mine, and sent me a text confirmation validating he did not.

It was impossible for me to enter the various text notices appearing from Attorney Phillips iPhone into mine. Attorney Phillips verified he did not enter the notices. Since I could not complete the entries into my iPhone and Attorney Phillips did not send them, the only remaining answer is that my iPhone is compromised and was operated by a malicious third party.


