

On 9/5/24 at 6:59 a.m. Hawaii Standard Time I submitted an extensive request for an investigation and intervention to the US House Oversight and Accountability Committee in Washington DC, referring to my various crime evidence website, links, and other data. My content included a six-page submission validating 31 ignored FBI/IC3 cyber crime complaints from 2016 - 2024, multi-federal agency collusion, whistleblower retribution, dozens of first and fourth Amendment violations, and other crimes, all known by low echelon agents through high-level government officials.

Although I received a submission validation from the House website, I surmise cyber criminals who conduct illegal surveillance of my network intercepted my US House submission and blocked it to prevent receipt. Such an action would be one of the more than 350 email, text, website, phone, and fax attempts I and hired staff have attempted that have been blocked via cyber attacks.

My claim can be verified by asking the House staff with an inquiry asking if my website submission was received on 9/5/24 at 6:59 a.m. Hawaii Standard Time.
